First Official Trailer and Poster Art for Indie Road Trip Thriller THE
POISONING

FMR Pictures and director Zachary Eglinton present the first official trailer and poster art for the indie road trip horror/thriller *The Poisoning*.

Eglinton's movie combines elements of low-budget mumblecore and horror to create a raw, haunting tale about paranoia and terror disrupting the friendships, and the lives, of three guys driving West to start anew.

Unlike many road trip features, *The Poisoning* is unique in that it was literally shot on a cross-country road trip in the short span of twelve days, with Eglinton moving to The Golden State in the process to reside there at the end of production. From Connecticut to California, the small six-person crew and a handful of actors forged ahead in the guerilla spirit of revered micro-budget independent films, such as award-winning favorites *El Mariachi* and *The Puffy Chair*. Being described by others as the epitome of independent, the team made use of every "found" resource and location they could on the shoot, while borrowing cars and crashing on the couches of friends and family scattered across the States.

The film stars Matt Mercer (*Madison County*), Kalan Ray (*Night of the Living Dead: Origins 3D*), Brandon Walz, Joanna Sotomura (*Madison County*), and Patrick Thomas Gorman (*My Name is Earl*).

The Poisoning will travel the festival circuit, and is aiming for release this winter.
